

REQUIREMENTS AND RULES FOR MASTER'S THESIS PROJECT

The defense of the master's thesis / master's project takes place at an open meeting of the Final Attestation Commission (IAC) with the participation of at least 2/3 of its members.

The presence of a supervisor and an official opponent at the defense is mandatory. In case of his absence for a good reason, the question of the possibility of protection is decided by the IAC.

No more than 8 papers can be heard at one meeting of the IAC. The list of graduate students should contain:

- 1) the surname, first name, patronymic of the undergraduate;
- 2) the topic of the master's thesis;
- 3) surname, academic degree and title of scientific supervisor;
- 4) the surname, academic degree and title of the opponents.

The chairman of the commission announces the defense of the thesis (the order of defense is in accordance with the list), announces the title of the topic, name, position, academic degree and academic title of the supervisor and official opponent. The secretary of the commission reads out the scientific and pedagogical characteristics of the undergraduate, the list of scientific papers, briefly reports on the contents of other documents related to the defense.

The master's student provides the members of the commission with an extended abstract of the dissertation research.

The master's student makes a report for no more than 15 minutes, in which he briefly and clearly characterizes the purpose and objectives of the study, outlines the most important provisions, justifiably argues conclusions and proposals. Then the master student answers questions from the IAC members.

The supervisor presents his conclusion on the dissertation. Then the official opponent speaks.

The master student briefly answers the main remarks, then he is given the final word. Based on the results of the defense of each work at this meeting, the IAC makes a decision on the assignment or non-assignment of an academic master's degree to a graduate student. The dissenting opinion of the members of the IAC is recorded in the protocol of protection.

When evaluating a dissertation, the following qualities are taken into account (Appendix E):

- amount of work performed;
- independence of research;
- application of new technologies in the work;
- completeness of the literary review and the modernity of the sources used;
- the possibility of applying the results obtained in scientific research, practical work or in the educational process;
- literacy and clarity of presentation of materials;
- the quality of the design and its compliance with the requirements;

- the quality of the report (literacy, clarity, ability to use professional terms, etc.), correctness and completeness of answers to questions asked during the defense and to the comments of the reviewer;

The number of publications on the work, the speeches of the undergraduate at scientific conferences.

Minutes of IAC meetings are kept for each undergraduate and are filled in by the secretary in the prescribed form.

Decisions on the evaluation of the master's thesis defense, as well as on the award of an academic degree and the issuance of a diploma (without distinction, with distinction) are made by the IAC at a closed meeting by secret ballot by a simple majority of the votes of the members of the commission who participated in the meeting.

The minutes are signed by the chairman and members of the state attestation commission who participated in the meeting.

The results of the defense of dissertations are announced on the day of their holding. According to the results of the dissertation defense, a decision is made on awarding an academic master's degree.

A master's student who has publicly defended a master's thesis / master's project is awarded the academic degree "Master of Medical Sciences/Master of Health" according to the educational program "code and name of the educational program" and is awarded a diploma of postgraduate education with an appendix (transcript).
