



Mission and policy of educational programs of postgraduate education (residency)

Policy:

- training in communication skills, knowledge, skills and practical skills in medical psychology and deontology;
- training in methods of treating common pathologies of various organs, taking into account age and physiological aspects;
- training in knowledge, skills and practical skills for carrying out manipulations;
- training of residents to provide emergency medical care in emergency situations;
- training residents to carry out sanitary and educational work to educate the population, promote a healthy lifestyle, dynamic monitoring of children and adults with screening and health measures;
- training in the application of the management principle in organizing their work, maintaining medical and accounting documentation and conducting medical and labor examination of patients.
